Tuition payment can be made either on-line via Paypal or in form of check payment. If paid in check, please make it payable to: **HXGNY** and mail it along with the printout sheet from the online registration system to: **HXGNY, P.O. Box 583, Purchase, NY 10577-0583.**

The tuition payment needs to be post marked within one (1) weeks of the enrollment date. Otherwise, the student may lose his or her enrollment priority. The School has the right to deny a student's acceptance if the payment has not been made in full and on time.

If a check is returned for any reason (e.g., insufficient funds, stop payment, or account closed), a \$35 processing fee in addition to any penalty amount charged by the bank will be added to your account. If a student with a bounced check decides to withdraw from the school, the \$35 returned check fee and bank charges should still apply.

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Refund Policy

- Since the tuition is paid for the whole school year, if a student decides to withdraw for the spring semester, he or she needs to inform the School Administration team before spring semester starts.
- For each semester,
 - ◇ Withdraw before the first week's class starts: \$50 per family management fee and \$40 per student registration fee non-refundable
 - ◇ Withdraw before the second week's class starts: 80% refund
 - ◇ Withdraw before the third week's class starts: 50% refund
 - ◇ Withdraw from the third week's class and after: 0% refund
- No partial credit will be granted for students registering a class in the middle of a semester. Instead a \$40 late registration fee will be added to the full tuition.
- No student should be allowed to sit in the class without FULL tuition payment, except for new students who get written permission from the School Administration team to audit the class.
- If you paid via Paypal, the refund will be returned to your Paypal account. If you paid with check, the refund will be issued to you with a school check. It normally takes 3 to 4 weeks to process the refund.

Grade/Class Assignment

Registration for New Students

Copy of birth certificate is required for all Pre-K (minimum enrollment age is 3yr old), Kindergarten students and all new students under age of 6.

New students should contact school registration (hxgny@googlegroups.com) to be evaluated and assigned to appropriate class based on the students' Chinese proficiency levels, subject to the availability of the grade/class.

Language Class Transfer for Existing Students

During the first 3 weeks of the new school year, if an existing student wants to transfer to a different grade or class, he or she needs to get a recommendation from his or her current teacher, written permission from the new teacher, and an approval from the School Administration team. The final transfer will also depend on the availability of the grade/class chosen by the student. Once approved, tuition and textbooks (new & unmarked) will be adjusted accordingly.

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Grade/Class Assignment

Culture Class Selection & Transfer

Except for pre-K and Kindergarten students, all other grades' students are encouraged to select a culture/activity class via on-line registration. There is a seat limit in each class. It is on a "first-come-first-serve" basis.

During the first 3 weeks of the new school year, if a student wants to change his or her current culture class selection, he or she can make a request via on-line registration system or to the School Administration team. However, the final transfer is subject to the availability and specific restrictions of the class that the student is interested in transferring to. Once the 4th week's class starts, no more transfers will be allowed.

The school reserves the right to adjust and make final decision on a student class assignment in order to balance the enrollment of classes in term of grade and activity area.

Culture Class Only Registration

Students can sign up for culture classes only. However, due to current online system's limitation, proper tuition (\$200 per culture class) and fees (\$50 family management fee per family and \$40 registration fee per student) may not be reflected correctly in the system.
